Kittner's photographs have been recognized by the leading graphics trade publications *Communication Arts (CA)* and *Photo District News (PDN)*. His documentary and fine art prints have been displayed at venues including the Corcoran Gallery of Art, Environmental Protection Agency, Peninsula Fine Arts Center, Smithsonian Museum of Natural History, Smithsonian Museum of American History, Washington Center for Photography, in corporate and private collections, and in the journal *Aperture*.

By shooting, blending, and digitally stitching multiple exposures of a scene together into a seamless composition, a passage of time is suspended within the confines of a still image. I capture dynamic panoramas that portray perspective and relationships that engage the viewer deeper into the scene."

During most of my commercial photography career, I have worked primarily as a people/portrait photographer, which I still actively pursue and enjoy. However springing from my panoramic work, I am thrilled to also be involved in the exciting world of creating architectural imagery, working with various architecture, construction, landscape, and institutional clients.
